~~Four Brothers: peaks, highest elevation 1,620 m (5,316 ft.), on Ship Mountain, in the Siskiyou Mountains, 17.7 km (11 mi.) SE of Gasquet; reportedly named prior to 1914 by William Lewis who was the first forest ranger in the Gasquet District, for the four Kelsey Brothers who built the Kelsey Trail; Del Norte, Calif.; secs. 25, 35 and 36, T 16 N, and sec. 2, T 15 N, R 3 E, Humboldt Mer.; 41°44'55" N, 123°47'07" W (N peak), 41°43'40" N, 123°47'40" W (S peak).~~

USGS (NMD), Ship Mountain 1:62; submitted to clarify application of the peaks in relation to Ship Mountain (q.v.); to identify four separate peaks on Ship Mountain which are numbered 1, 2, 3, and 4, and named collectively Four Brothers; field report states both names are in use; USGS maps use name; county and USFS maps use only Ship Mountain; however, the county map does show four separate peaks; in Six Rivers NF.
