Not: Mammoth Spring; so named because the water in this stream is several degrees warmer than that of Spring River; Fulton County, Arkansas, and Howell and Oregon Counties, Missouri; N $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. 8, T. 21 N., R. 5 W., fifth principal meridian; $36^{\circ}29'40''$ N., $91^{\circ}32'09''$ W.
