Description:

Warm Fork Spring River: stream about 26 miles long, heading in Missouri at the junction of Howell Creek and an unnamed tributary about 2.4 miles north-northeast of Brandsville, at about 36°40'52" N., 91°40'40" W., and flowing generally south-south-eastward, into Arkansas, to Spring River just east of the town of Mammoth Spring; so named because the water in this stream is several degrees warmer than that of Spring River; Fulton County, Arkansas, and Howell and Oregon Counties, Missouri; N $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. 8, T. 21 N., R. 5 W., fifth principal meridian; 36°29'40" N., 91°32'09" W. Not: Spring River [q.v.].
