Description ^{See work card} a small lake about 3/4 mile southeast of Nahsukin Peak on the headwaters of Waterton River, near lat. 48°50' N., long. 113°58'30" W., in the Glacier National Park, Glacier County, Mont. Nahsukin is a Kootenai word that means "chief."
