Okanogan: a town near the confluence of Salmon Creek and Okanogan River, near 48°22' N., 119°35' W., Okanogan County, Wash. (Not Okinakane nor Alma.)

Okanogan County: a county in north central Washington bordering Canada. (Not Okinakane.)

Okanogan River: a river, Okanogan County, Wash., leaves Osoyoos Lake on the United States-Canada boundary in secs. 21 and 22, T. 40 N., R. 27 E., Willamette meridian, near 48°57' N., 119°26' W., flows south into Columbia River on western edge of Colville Indian Reservation in sec. 17, T. 30 N., R. 25 E., Willamette meridian, near 48°06' N., 119°44' W. The part of the river in Canada is called Okanagan. (Not Okinakane.)
