SAUSALITO; a Post Office in California, (in place of some seven variations). Referred to Mr. George Davidson of the Coast and Geodetic Survey and to Mr. Barstow, of the Post Office Dept. Mr. Davidson reports that the spelling recommended was the original Spanish spelling which was retained up to 1850, since which time the spelling "Saucelito" became almost universal as applied to the Bay. The name of the Post Office was originally spelled in like manner, but changed to its present form "Sausalito" in 1887. The reversion to the former spelling would involve considerable trouble to the Post Office Department, which does not under the circumstances appear to the Committee to be warranted.
