ENE of Monteith; name of the colonial plantation of Lieutenant-Governor John Graham, which was named for the mulberry trees grown in connection with a silk industry; in 1785 the Georgia Legislature gave the land to General Nathanael Green for services in the Revolutionary War; Chatham Co., Ga.; 32°11'25" N, 81°09'35" W. Variants: Josephs Town, Mulberry Grove Plantation.
