Reply from postmaster at Chincoteague Island, May 1942: The name of this post office is Chincoteague Island, and the town is incorporated under the name "Town of Chincoteague", so with the public in general the name of "Chincoteague" is what is used.

Presumably the titles of the two new quadrangles CHINCOTEAGUE EAST and CHINCOTEAGUE WEST will not be affected by any decision in the above conflict. About half of the town is on each of them, but the titles would seem to be derived from the prevalence of the name Chincoteague in the vicinity, rather than from any one feature bearing that name.
