Description a mountain in sec. 3, T. 51. N., R. 107. W., 6th P. M., approximately lat. 44°25' N., long. 109°44' W., Shoshone National Forest, Park County, Wyo. Named for Forest Ranger Alfred G. Clayton, killed August 21, 1937, in a forest fire on the slope of the mountain.
