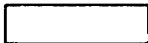

* Wasson Peak: peak, elevation 4,687 ft., in the Tucson Mountains 11 mi. NW of Tucson; named for John Wasson (1883-1909), editor of the Arizona Citizen, 1870, and Surveyor General of Arizona 1870-1882; Pima Co., Ariz.; sec. 29, T 13 S, R 12 E, Gila and Salt River mer.; 32°16'24" N, 111°08'48" W. Not: Amole Peak [former decision], Wasson's Peak.

USGS, Cortaro 1:62; 1941 decision revised; USGS reports that Wasson Peak was the original name of this feature and that this name is still in common local use; USNPS and local people strongly recommend this name; in Saguaro National Monument; not in a USNF but shown on Coronado NF map.
