## Local usage

"Mud Lake is the most common name. However, Canoe Lake has some local use and is shown on the U.S.G.S. advance quadrangle sheets. The recommended name is said to have originated from an old dugout canoe abandoned on the lake by an old trapper who lived near the lake about 1905. Until recently the remains of the old canoe could still be seen on the shore of the lake." (U.S.F.S., 6/14/40.)
