West Fork Little Thompson River: stream about 10 miles long, heading at about  $40^{\circ}15'38''$  N.,  $105^{\circ}29'45''$  W. and flowing generally northeastward, through Big Elk Park, to the Little Thompson River about 7 miles northwest of Lyons and 19 miles north-northwest of Boulder; Boulder and Larimer Counties, Colorado; NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 29, T. 4 N., R. 71 W., sixth principal meridian;  $40^{\circ}17'16''$  N.,  $105^{\circ}22'29''$  W.
