Crystal Peak: peak, elevation 1,097 m (3,600 ft.), in the Santa Cruz Mountains 5.3 km (3.3 mi.) NW of Svedal and 17.7 km (11 mi.) SE of Los Gatos; named for the radio communications facility on the peak and to commemorate early crystal radio development; Santa Clara Co., Calif.; sec. 35, T 9 S, R 1 E, Mount Diablo Mer.; 37°06'48" N, 121°50'05" W.

Howard Krawetz, Loma Prieta 1:24; submitted to give official recognition to a name used in State and Federal documents; reportedly the name is shown on the county of Santa Clara Sheriff's Master Dispatch Map and it is also used in the Federal Communications Commission Frequency Master File; reportedly a commercial radio frequency and microwave relay site has been built on the peak; the peak is unnamed on Federal maps; not in a USNF.
