Pinchot 1:62; name proposal for a previously unnamed feature; name is from the Greek words Acrodictes Philopagus," meaning "summit biter," an unusual cricket found only in the Sierra Nevada Mts. and generally above 12,000 feet; nearly 4 times as many of these crickets were found on this peak as on any other (some 250) peaks ascended in the mountains; not in, but area covered by Inyo NF map.
