Pioneer Mountains: range, 64 km (40 mi.) long, highest elevation 3,681 m (12,078 ft.), in Challis National Forest; bounded on the W by the Big Wood River, Trail and Summit Creeks, and the North Fork Big Lost River, on the N and E by the East Fork Big Lost River, Left Fork Cherry Creek, Cherry Creek, Dry Fork Creek, Saint Louis Canyon, and Champagne Creek, and on the S by the Snake River Plain; Butte, Custer and Blaine Cos., Idaho; 43°37'00"N, 114°00'00"W; 1965 description revised; USGS map - Idaho Falls 1:250,000.

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
