Upper McCabe Lake: lake about 0.5 mile long and 0.2 mile wide and largest of the McCabe Lakes, in Yosemite National Park, just south of Shepherd Crest, about 0.8 mile north-northwest of North Peak, and 11.2 miles west-northwest of Lee Vining; Tuolumne County; secs. 33 and 34, T. 2 N., R. 24 E., Mount Diablo meridian; 37°59'45" N., 119°19'20" W. Not: McCabe Lake.
