"In 1896-98 it was named McClintock Peak by William Jackson, (Siksikakoan), formerly a famous Blackfoot scout attached to Gen'l Custer's command, and later guide for the Government expedition under Gifford Pinchot, which was engaged in locating national forest reserves, and to which Walter McClintock also belonged."
