

Adopted name Tatk Kam Vo

Description a small village about 3 1/2 miles southwest of Pisinimo, near lat. 32°0'30" N., long. 112°22' W., Papago Indian Reservation, Pima County, Ariz.

Tatk Kam Vo is a Papago name that means "root place charco."

(Not Nestor's nor Iramit.)

According to the Office of Indian Affairs, this village has been called Nestor's and also Iramit. Neither of those names have been found on maps.

Local usage

"The recommended name (Tatk Kam Vo) is the name generally used and understood by Papagos. It should be written in three words because it actually consists of three words, and if not correctly accented, has another meaning. The name "Iramit" is not acceptable to the residents."
