

Adopted name Sawbill Creek

Description a creek that leaves Sawbill Lake in SW 1/4 sec. 7, T.62 N., R.4 W., and flows southerly and southeasterly entering Temperance River in SW 1/4 sec. 28, T.62 N., R.4 W., fourth principal meridian, Superior National Forest, Cook County, Minn. Name approved by Minnesota State Geographic Board, May 20, 1940, and Cook County Board, March 11, 1941. (Not North Branch Temperance River nor West Branch Temperance River.)
