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Mummy Cave Ruins: site, in Canyon de Chelly National Monument, in
Mummy Cave, cliff dwelling on the E rim of Canyon del Muerto 0.48 km
(0.3 mi.) N of Tseh-Ya Kin Canyon and 17.7 km (11 mi.) WSW of
Tsaile, Apache Co., Ariz.; 36°13'57" N, 109°21'20" W.

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USGS (NMD), Canyon del Muerto 1:62; submitted to give official recognition to a name reported to be in local use according to USGS field investigation; all available maps use recommended name; reportedly this location is the site of ruins under a large overhanging sandstone wall where a well-preserved mummy was found; USGS field report indicates that U.S. National Park Service uses recommended name; not in a USNF.
